Introduction

This is the Paris Agreement Monitor, which tracks key developments in the Paris Agreement negotiation process reported up to the last day of the reference month.

The Monitor presents retrospective updates related to the previous month and upcoming developments for the current month, based on official agendas and publications available on the UNFCCC website. It also includes open calls for submissions and recent submissions made by Parties and UNFCCC bodies.

The updates are organized according to the main thematic pillars of the Paris Agreement negotiations and include links to the original related pages and documents.

Glossary

A6.4: Article 6.4 mechanism. A mechanism under the Paris Agreement that enables mitigation activities and the issuance of Article 6.4 emission reductions under the supervision of the Article 6.4 Supervisory Body.

AC: Adaptation Committee. A constituted body under the UNFCCC that promotes coherent implementation of adaptation through technical guidance, knowledge-sharing and support to Parties.

ACE: Action for Climate Empowerment. A term adopted under the UNFCCC to refer to work related to education, training, public awareness, public participation, public access to information and international cooperation on climate change.

AILAC: Independent Association of Latin America and the Caribbean. Group of Latin American and Caribbean countries that coordinates positions and proposals in international climate negotiations.

AOSIS: Alliance of Small Island States. Coalition of small island and low-lying coastal developing States that advocates for ambitious climate action due to their high vulnerability to climate change impacts.

BAR: Baku Adaptation Road Map. A process under the UNFCCC adaptation agenda to advance technical work and workshops related to adaptation under the global goal on adaptation and related mandates.

BTR: Biennial Transparency Report. A reporting instrument under the Enhanced Transparency Framework of the Paris Agreement.

CGE: Consultative Group of Experts. A constituted body under the UNFCCC that supports developing country Parties in implementing transparency arrangements.

CMA: Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement. It is the decision-making body of the Paris Agreement.

COP: Conference of the Parties to the UNFCCC. It is the decision-making body of the Convention.

EID: Earth Information Day. Event held to promote exchanges between the scientific community and policymakers on the state of the climate system.

EIG: Environmental Integrity Group. Negotiating coalition under the UNFCCC composed of countries from different regions that cooperate on climate negotiation issues.

ETF: Enhanced Transparency Framework under the Paris Agreement. Transparency system established under Article 13 of the Paris Agreement to improve reporting, tracking and review of climate action and support provided and received by Parties.

FTC: Financial, technical and capacity-building support under the Enhanced Transparency Framework reporting tools.

FWG: Facilitative Working Group of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform. Body established to operationalize the LCIPP and facilitate the exchange of knowledge, experiences and best practices related to climate change.

GCNMA: Glasgow Committee on Non-market Approaches. Committee established to support work on non-market approaches under Article 6, paragraph 8, of the Paris Agreement.

GHG: Greenhouse gas. Atmospheric gases that trap heat and contribute to global warming, including carbon dioxide, methane and nitrous oxide.

KCI: Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures.

LCIPP: Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform. Platform established under the UNFCCC to strengthen the knowledge, technologies, practices and efforts of Indigenous Peoples and local communities related to addressing and responding to climate change.

LDC: Least Developed Country/Countries. Category of countries recognized by the United Nations with specific development and climate vulnerability considerations in the UNFCCC process.

LEG: Least Developed Countries Expert Group.

LMDC: Like-Minded Developing Countries.

MEP: Methodological Expert Panel. A panel that supports the development of methodologies and related guidance under the Article 6.4 mechanism.

NAP: National Adaptation Plan. A planning instrument through which countries identify and address medium- and long-term adaptation needs.

NDC: Nationally Determined Contribution. A document submitted by Parties to the Paris Agreement outlining their climate commitments and actions.

NMA: Non-market approaches under Article 6, paragraph 8, of the Paris Agreement.

PA: Paris Agreement.

PCCB: Paris Committee on Capacity-building. Constituted body under the UNFCCC established to address gaps and needs related to capacity-building in developing countries.

RCC: Regional Collaboration Centre. A UNFCCC-supported centre that assists countries and stakeholders in implementing climate action at the regional level.

REDD+: Reducing emissions from deforestation and forest degradation, and the role of conservation, sustainable management of forests and enhancement of forest carbon stocks in developing countries.

SB: Subsidiary Bodies. Collective reference to the two permanent subsidiary bodies of the UNFCCC: the SBI and the SBSTA.

SBI: Subsidiary Body for Implementation. UNFCCC subsidiary body responsible for supporting the implementation of the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement through technical, administrative and procedural work.

SBSTA: Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice. UNFCCC subsidiary body that provides scientific, technical and methodological advice to support climate negotiations and implementation processes.

SCF: Standing Committee on Finance. Constituted body under the UNFCCC that supports the COP in matters related to climate finance, including coordination, transparency and mobilization of financial resources.

SDG: Sustainable Development Goal. One of the goals adopted under the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

SEORS: Side Events and Exhibits Online Registration System. UNFCCC system used for information related to side events and exhibits.

SSJW: Sharm el-Sheikh joint work on implementation of climate action on agriculture and food security. A workstream under the UNFCCC addressing climate action in agriculture and food security.

UAE: United Arab Emirates.

UNFCCC: United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change. International treaty adopted in 1992 that provides the foundational legal and institutional framework for global cooperation to address climate change.

WIM: Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage. Mechanism established under the UNFCCC to address loss and damage associated with the adverse effects of climate change, including extreme weather events and slow onset events.

NAZCA: Non-State Actor Zone for Climate Action. A UNFCCC platform and initiative for recording and communicating climate action by non-Party stakeholders.
